West Central Community Action – 55 and over unemployed to help them find employment, looking for host 501 c3 and gov't agencies; working to get school supplies for back to school starts Aug. 8 from 9-3pm if gone they will make other arrangements. Now have funding for an air conditioner – must have a doctors note. Public Allies – 17 on up 42 hours per week for 10 months, cost is \$1400. Do have gift cards can give out if people have already used their 2 visits for food – only if referred by agency

CCHHH – awarded maternal child health grant again, finally fully staffed, still doing home visits for family steps, very part time interpreter and a summer interpreter starting at the end of July.

AEA – birth to 5 for children with special needs – Denison, Charter Oak Ute, and Mapleton

1st 5 – links Health Care Providers, had human trafficking presentation “Set me Free”

HUD office – Angie Mc Cullum – has a 2 month waiting list, accept applications at the WIC clinic July 12, 10-12 Pioneer Baptist Church need SS card and ID.

ISU – most counties dealing with Fair, has been doing farmers markets, Storm Lake Dave Brown for relationship skills training for agencies Aug. 19th

Cross Roads of Crawford County – resource and referral for all family and life issues, try to use volunteers (pregnancy, family, care taker resources, elderly services), looking for volunteers, will start fund raising.

Child Health Specialty clinics Birth through 21 years of age, and Reginal Autism Program and training on July 19th from 8-5 Autism Symposium.

Early Childhood Iowa – legislation passed, state board will be looking at new funding methods and formulas that currently limit the ability to use available money. Essentials training, which is 12 hours, child care home who accepts child care assistance; coming this fall.
