Family STEPS is currently offering virtual visits. Baby Boutique classes are on hold. Working to do a six week Community Education session using Great Beginnings a curriculum from ISU Extension. Any families interested please refer. Boys Town of Iowa – Sonja F contact Amy T. at CCHHH&PH about Common Sense Parenting, do not want to duplicate or compete with community education to families.

Family STEPS currently has 38 families on levels one and two. Visits up a little, reaching out more often, which is good. Question asked about the most repeated or high requested need. Answer: Hispanic clients asking for help with paper work, paying bills because unable to read and write. Food is big, Crawford County has done well to provide.

Council: Switched to have Crawford County Home Health, Hospice & Public Health be the Contract Holder. The Council only has one program contracting with Prevent Child Abuse Iowa, will make it easier to receive payments and provide reports.
