##### a. Program Updates:

1. Parent Education supplement the Family Steps program in Buena Vista County, awarded 67% of requested amount \$13,400.
2. Sexual Abuse Prevention, CASSA will do presentations in schools to children awarded 57% of requested amount \$5,700.00

Hiring Bachelor level person and others to work for the Rolling Hills Region. Discussion held over lack of mental health emergency slots available in Iowa. Have walk in slots available at 1:00 every day at Plains Area Mental Health. Looking to revise structure in future for all intakes.
SALUD Di Daniels	Congratulations for getting Volunteer of the Year. Have interpreter who works with Child Care Resource and Referral (CCR&R) and Renee Sweers to offer childcare class for people providing child care in their homes. CCR&R offered ChildNet.
