Completed and reviewed a Health & Safety assessment with a center who wants to make improvements within their ECE environment, and most improvements have been made. CCNC was contacted by a center regarding concerns to their outdoor play area. Discussion was centered around safety concerns and upgrades to the play area. Recently the upgrades have been completed. Completed three (3) face to face training courses this quarter: (2) Playground Supervision and Sun Safety and (1) Medication Administration Skills Competency with all participants reporting increased knowledge after attending. Other funds were used for the one (1)-DOE visit listed.</p>
